

RENEWAL OF LOANS

- Self-Renewing option via user account, as long as the items are not overdue and reserved by other readers
- Maximum 182 day loan period

RETURNING ITEMS

- During opening hours at self-returns machine in the foyer
- Also possible at the other HU libraries (exception: Law Branch Library)
- Return and re-lending at the return machine of all library holdings

SCANNING

- Scanner A3 and scan tents
- Free of charge

SEARCHING FOR ITEMS

- Searching for books, journals, articles (printed and online) in the Primus Gateway: primus.ub.hu-berlin.de/en
- Help: Information desk, subject librarians

STUDY CARRELS

- 14 one- or two-persons carrels for students of Humboldt Universität zu Berlin working on their final exam papers
- One-month reservation period
- Application forms are available at the circulation desk

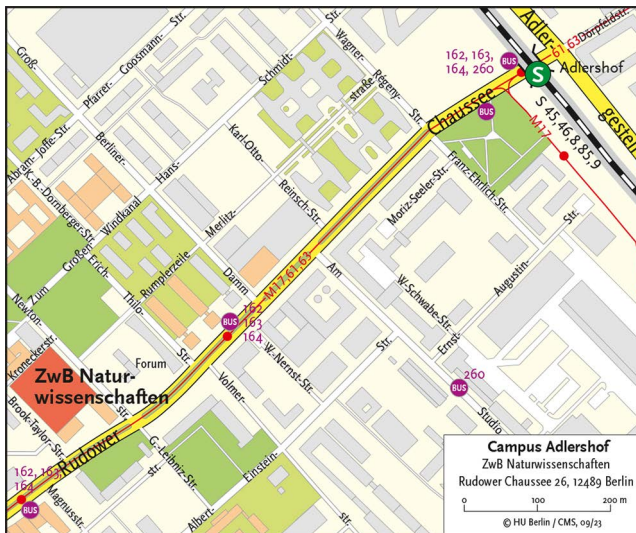

- Free of charge



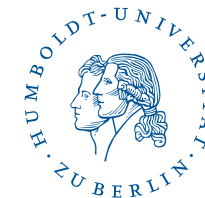

Erwin-Schrödinger-Zentrum

The Erwin-Schrödinger-Zentrum runs according to the motto of providing one-stop service. Library and Computer and Media Service form an integrated whole to their users. More than 500 000 volumes on Chemistry, Geography, Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics and Psychology are shelved open access. There is space for more than 430 readers, including 180 PC workstations, rooms for group study and study carrels, several workplaces for disabled readers and wireless networking. Hence the readers may find state of the art work conditions at the Erwin-Schrödinger-Zentrum. Long opening hours, specialist counselling, self-issue and return machines as well as a café complete the services.

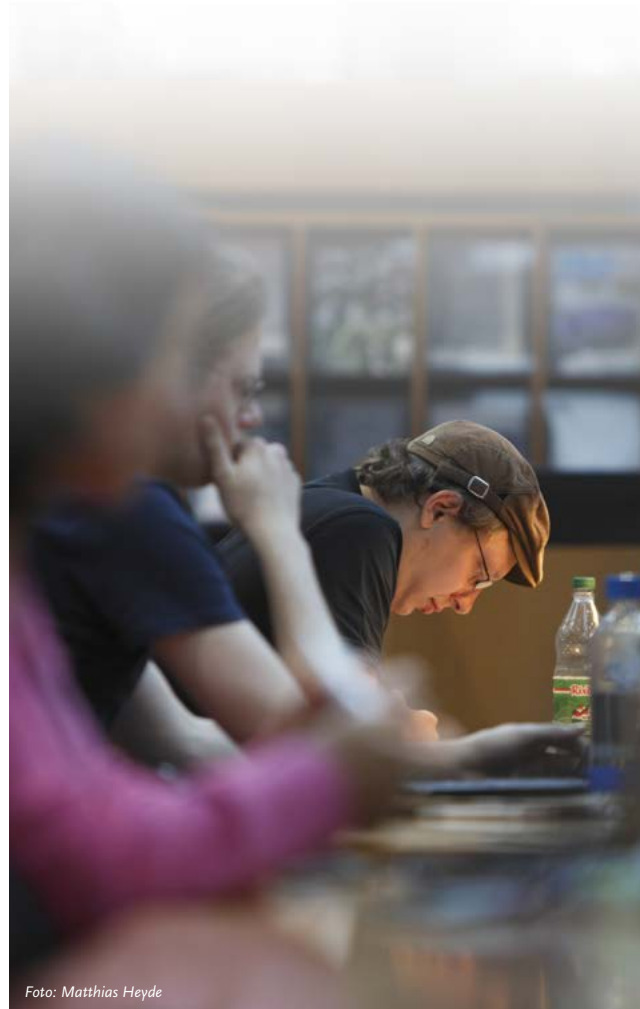

The Science Branch Library from A to Z

ACCESSIBILITY

- Parking space for the disabled and barrier-free access
- Barrier-free counter and toilet, lift from ground floor to gallery
- Height-adjustable desks in the reading room
- Study carrel for visually handicapped readers
- Loan period: 84 days

BOOK TROLLEYS

- Five trolleys for Ph.D. and other students of Humboldt-Universität zu Berlin working on their final exam papers and visiting scientists
- One-month reservation period
- Application forms are available at the circulation desk

BORROWING

- Loan period: 28 days
- Fees are only charged for overdue loans
- Limits: 182 days and 100 items in total (all HU libraries)
- Self-check-out machines
- Pick up reserved books at a shelf in the textbook collection
- Books are reserved for 7 days

CHILDREN

- Workplace for studying with children with play area at the textbook collection
- Pencils and bags with books and toys can be borrowed for a day

CLOAKROOM LOCKERS

- Lockers with your own padlock (lock hasp must be 5–6mm diameter)
- Bags (and similar things) must be left in the lockers
- Utilisation during opening hours, checked and cleared after closing

COURSES

- Searching for items: Discover search tools, databases and reference management

GROUP STUDY ROOMS

- For group learning and discussions on the gallery
- Equipped with smartboards and whiteboards (markers must be provided by users themselves)
- Reservation at the circulation desk



INTERNET ACCESS

- HU students: with CMS account (automatically with matriculation)
- All other users: with library account only, after setting a secure password

MEETING AND SOLO BOXES

- Soundproof booths for group work or participation in video conferences for 1 - 4 persons (without reservation)
- Two meeting boxes between the reading room and the PC room
- Two telephone boxes next to the lending machines and one near to computer science holdings

MENSACARD

- For paying fees
- Recharging at the automat in the cloakroom
- Buying, returning as well as recharging at the students' canteen Oase

OFFICE SUPPLY VENDING MACHINE

- Vends BiBtaschen for use inside the library, padlocks and more
- Payment only by EC card
- Located in the locker room

OPEN SHELF ACCESS

- More than 500 000 freely-accessible volumes
- Direct shelf browsing through subject-wise classification

REGISTERING

- HU students: Registered automatically with matriculation
- All others: Registration with ID card or with passport and proof of residency
- free of charge
