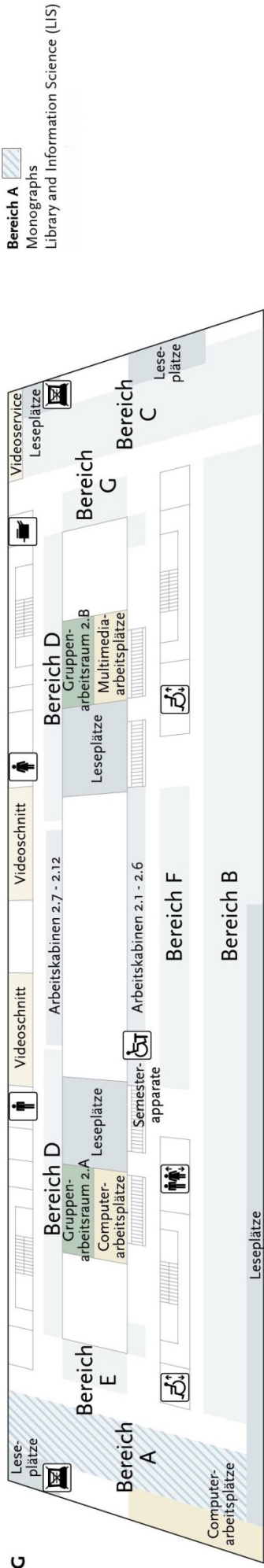

Provides access to the full texts of about 60% of the indexed documents for free. Indexes the metadata of academically relevant journals, institutional repositories, digital collections etc.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • https://www.base-search.net/ 	<p>Karlsruhe Virtual Catalogue (KVK)</p> <p>Meta search engine for more than 500 million books and serials in library and book trade catalogues worldwide. <p>Bibliotheks-Glossar*</p> <p>A glossary that contains about 90,000 technical terms and abbreviations about libraries, books and data processing. <p>German Journal Database (ZDB)</p> <p>Bibliographic database of printed and electronic serial titles. Holdings information for German and Austrian libraries. Allows users to search current and retrospective information from journals, books, and proceedings across a wide range of disciplines. Allows cited reference searching to track a paper's influence. 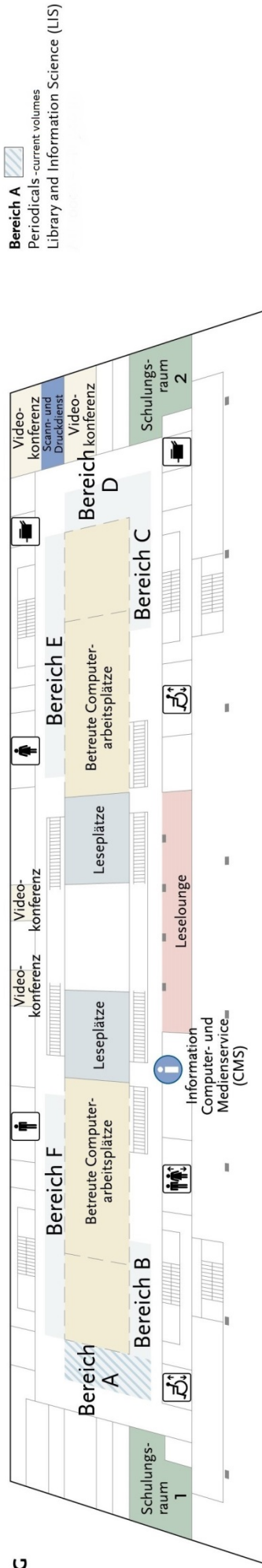
Plan of Jacob-and-Wilhelm-Grimm-Zentrum

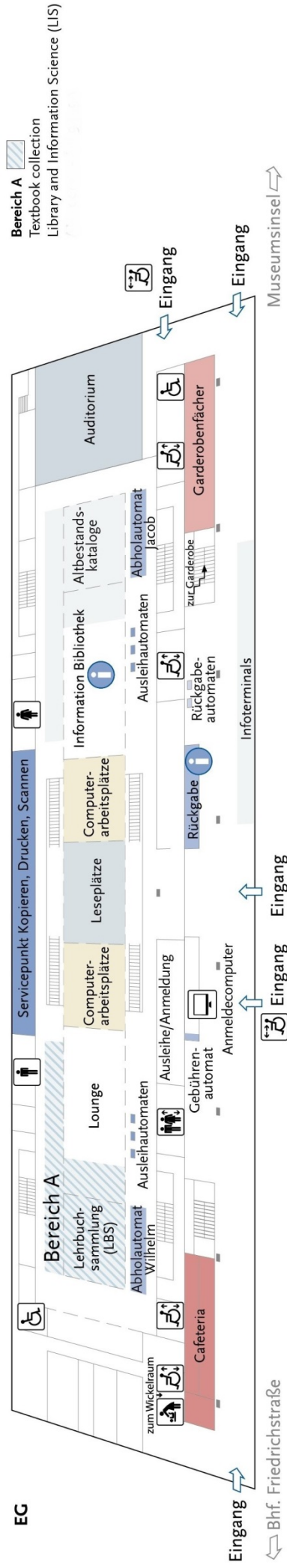
